1776 - 2026: Honoring Our Past, Inspiring Our Future

Fairfield County's Role in the Revolution

The Burning of Fairfield (1779): British General William Tryon burned the town to the ground in retaliation for patriot resistance. Many families lost their homes, yet the community rebuilt stronger.

Danbury Raid (1777): Fairfield County supplied men to defend nearby Danbury when the British attacked and destroyed Continental Army provisions.

Battle of Ridgefield (1777): General Benedict Arnold fought bravely against the British, earning temporary fame before his later betrayal

Privateering & Coastal Raids: Norwalk and Stamford became hubs of privateering, with patriots seizing British supply ships in Long Island Sound.

Patriot Leaders: General Gold Selleck Silliman of Fairfield led militia forces but was captured in a Loyalist raid. His wife, Mary Silliman, carried on his work, managing the farm and supporting the patriot cause during his imprisonment.

Did You Know?

Fairfield County towns were attacked multiple times, making the region a frontline buffer between British New York and Patriot New England.

> The county's coastline provided secret crossings for supplies and intelligence between Connecticut patriots and allies on Long Island.

> > After the Burning of Norwalk (1779), only a handful of houses survived - yet the people rebuilt with resilience

Historic Norwalk cemetery dating back to 1886 cemetery grounds blessed by local priests and ministers all denominations welcome

The Riverside Cemetery is certainly a location of historical significance to the City of Norwalk. The first burial was recorded in December 1886. Its' Gate House was built at the Cemetery entrance in 1899 and now serves as a Chapel/Gathering Room and administrative offices. The Cemetery is classified as an ancient burial ground, existing at the same location for well over 100 years. A quiet sanctuary to visit loved ones - people are often surprised to learn that there are still plots available amidst the 60 acres. Design help and installation is offered for memorial stone work for those interred at the Cemetery. Veteran sections are dedicated to honoring our Civil War, World War I, World War II and Vietnam veterans. Riverside has also served a growing number of people by providing burials for their pets. Two separate sections are exclusively set aside for pet burials.

Converting to a non-profit in January 2021, ancestors of the same founding family continue to direct the Cemetery's affairs. The family is dedicated to the past for the benefit of the present and the future for many more years to come.



About Us

A National Historic Landmark since 1971, the Lockwood-Mathews Mansion Museum is an award-winning institution and regarded as one of the earliest and most significant Second Empire Style country houses in the United States. The Mansion, built between 1864 and 1868, was designed by architect Detlef Lienau for renowned financier and railroad baron LeGrand Lockwood and his wife Ann Louisa. This historic house features interiors and furnishings by such notable designers as the Herter Brothers, Léon Marcotte, and George Platt.

Following Lockwood's untimely death in 1872, Charles Drelincourt Mathews, a wealthy merchant from New York, purchased the Mansion as a summer home for his wife, Rebecca, and their four children. Their eldest son, Charles T. Mathews, is known to have designed the Lady Chapel in St. Patrick's Cathedral, NYC.

The City of Norwalk purchased the property in 1941. Today, the Mansion stands as an iconic treasure, with breathtaking interiors and furniture that illustrate magnificently the beauty and splendor of the Victorian era.

Our Mission

The Mission of the Lockwood-Mathews Mansion Museum is to preserve and restore this unique architectural treasure and National Historic Landmark, and to make art, history, and science inspiring, educational, and accessible to all. The Museum strives to interpret the mid-to-late 19th and early 20th centuries through public programs that engage and enrich our communities, while encouraging dialogue, learning, and creativity.

Lockwood-Mathews is dedicated to conserving and faithfully restoring the Mansion as a national historic landmark in CT and ensuring it remains a vital link to the region's past and a platform for its future.
