> A 250th anniversary is the semiguincentennial.

The area occupied by present-day Sudbury and nearby towns was known to Indigenous people as Musketaquid, which is Algonquin for "grassy plain" or "place where the water flows through the grasses".

The Warren Clock Company, later Telechron, was based in Ashland from 1912 to 1992. Ashland's nickname is Clocktown.

Opened in 1951, Shoppers' World in Framingham was the first regional shopping mall east of the Rockies and the second in the country.

> In 1846, 1,666 acres of Holliston was ceded to form part of the Town of Ashland.

John Dickman, farmer and teamster from Hopkinton, was a member of the Sons of Liberty and took part in the **Boston Tea Party.**

Natick is the birthplace of modern baseball and the site of the first baseball factory in the United States.

> From 1955 to 1974 Wayland housed a Nike missile base on Oxbow Road —one of only three Boston-area sites.
