On July 4, 2026, our nation will commemorate and celebrate the 250th anniversary of the signing of the **Declaration of Independence**. The journey toward this historic milestone is an opportunity to pause and reflect on our nation's past, honor the contributions of all Americans, and look ahead toward the future we want to create for the next generation and beyond.



### The most significant Events in US History over the Past 250 Years

#### JULY 4, 1776 – Signing of the Declaration of Independence

By issuing the Declaration of Independence, adopted by the Continental Congress on July 4, 1776, the 13 American colonies severed their political connections to Great Britain. The Declaration summarized the colonists' motivations for seeking independence. By declaring themselves an independent nation, the American colonists were able to confirm an official alliance with the Government of France and obtain French assistance in the war against Great Britain.

#### **DECEMBER 20, 1803** – Louisianna Purchase

The Louisiana Purchase was the purchase of imperial rights to the western half of the Mississippi River basin from France by the United States in 1803. The deal granted the United States the sole authority to obtain the land from its indigenous inhabitants, either by contract or by conquest.

### APRIL 9, 1865 – End of the Civil War

Trapped by the Federals near Appomattox Court House, Confederate general Robert E. Lee surrendered his army to Union general Ulysses S. Grant, precipitating the capitulation of other Confederate forces and leading to the end of the bloodiest conflict in American history.

**NOVEMBER 11, 1918 – End of World War I**After more than four years of horrific fighting and the loss of millions of lives, the guns on the Western Front fell silent. Although fighting continued elsewhere, the armistice between Germany and the Allies was the first step to ending World War I.

#### **DECEMBER 7, 1941 – Bombing of Pearl Harbor**

On December 7, 1941, the Imperial Japanese Navy launched a surprise military attack on the U.S. naval base at Pearl Harbor in Hawaii, effectively bringing the United States into World War II by shocking the nation with the sudden assault on American soil; this event is widely known as the "Bombing of Pearl Harbor."

#### SEPTEMBER 2, 1945 - End of World War II

On May 8, 1945, Germany surrendered. After the atomic bomb was dropped on Hiroshima and Nagasaki, Japan surrendered on September 2, 1945, and the Second World War came to an end.

### **NOVEMBER 22, 1963 – Assassination of JFK**

President John F. Kennedy was assassinated while riding in a motorcade through Dallas, Texas, when he was shot by Lee Harvey Oswald, who was positioned in the Texas School Book Depository building; Kennedy was pronounced dead at Parkland Memorial Hospital shortly after the shooting.

#### **JULY 20, 1969** – First Man on the Moon

Neil Armstrong became the first person to walk on the moon as part of the Apollo 11 mission. Armstrong was the commander of the Apollo 11 mission, and Edwin "Buzz" Aldrin was the lunar module pilot.

#### APRIL 30, 1975 – End of the Vietnam War

The end of the Vietnam War, as North Vietnamese forces captured the South Vietnamese capital of Saigon (now Ho Chi Minh City), signifying the fall of the South Vietnamese government and the official conclusion of US involvement in the conflict.

#### SEPTEMBER 11, 2001 – Terrorist Attack on US

Four coordinated Islamist terrorist suicide attacks carried out by al-Qaeda against the United States in 2001. Nineteen terrorists hijacked four commercial airliners, crashing the first two into the Twin Towers of the World Trade Center in New York City and the third into the Pentagon (headquarters of the United States Department of Defense) in Arlington County, Virginia. The fourth plane crashed in a rural Pennsylvania field during a passenger revolt. The September 11 attacks killed 2,977 people, making it the deadliest terrorist attack in history.

### JUNE 26, 2015 – Supreme Court Ratifies Gay Marriage


Supreme Court of the United States ruled in the case of Obergefell v. Hodges that a fundamental right to marry is guaranteed to same-sex couples by the Fourteenth Amendment, and that states must allow same-sex marriage.
